INSPECTION OF CONSUMER’S WIRING

POLICY

It shall be the policy of M.J.M. Electric Cooperative to inspect, before connection to electric facilities of the Cooperative, Member’s service entrance wiring and installation only through the main disconnect the entrance panel and provisions for emergency power. Said inspection is to be solely for the purpose of the Cooperative.


RESPONSIBILITY

President/CEO and Director of Engineering and Operations

PROCEDURE

All secondary voltage electric wiring on consumer’s premises shall conform to the National Electrical Code, applicable state and local codes and wiring specification adopted from time to time by the Cooperative. Inspection of consumer’s service entrance wiring and installation through the main disconnect shall be done by the Cooperative Linemen prior to connection to the Cooperative facilities.

The Lineman will refuse to connect service to consumer’s wiring when said wiring and installation appears to be in a hazardous condition. Cooperative personnel shall have the right, but not the obligation to inspect the installation and use of standby equipment to ensure that adequate provisions have been made to separate standby equipment from central service.
