DISCONNECTION OF ELECTRIC SERVICE DURING
HOT AND COLD WEATHER

POLICY

Electric service to a residential Consumer-Member, unless on Prepaid Electric Service, including tenants of apartment buildings, will not be disconnected for non-payment of bills.

- A. On any day when the National Weather Service forecast for the following 24 hours covering the Cooperative's service area in which the electric service is located, includes a forecast that the temperature will be 32 degrees Fahrenheit or below and 90 degrees Fahrenheit or above.

- B. On any day preceding a holiday or weekend.
